

Parent Child Interaction Process

Following the completion of the community context mapping process in March, a second meeting of the Child Well Being task force, May 4, 2010, centered around a creation of a strategic plan for parent-child interaction. There were 17 task force members attending the second meeting, with Sara Sulzbach of PPHD as the facilitator. Many of the same individuals from the previous meeting were present, however there were some new members from the foster parenting program for children with special needs.

The overarching focus question addressed was: *How can we, in the next 5 years, ensure the system-wide use of effective policies and practices to support positive parent child interaction and impact child well being indicators?*

The strategic planning was designed to be a two-part process, addressing a practical vision and underlying contradictions at the May 4 meeting, with a second meeting planned for June 24 to address strategic directions and a focused implementation plan. Documents supporting the entire strategic planning process and completion of the practical vision and underlying contradictions workshops are included with this submission.
