Nonprofit leadership training offered in Alliance

Nonprofits are held to a very high level of accountability – to their funders, their board and their staff – but still must operate on a shoestring budget. Even with a paid director, the nonprofit has different needs than the usual for profit business on Main Street. A series of one-day workshops will be offered in Alliance to address the leadership needs of the small Panhandle nonprofit agency.

The six modules, taught by the Nonprofit Leadership institute and offered by the Panhandle Partnership Training Academy, begin Wednesday, March 16 at Box Butte General Hospital's Alliance. The trainings will continue through April 14, with a different topic for each date. The dates and topics are:

- ***Foundations of Leadership*** ***March 16***
- ***Leading the Nonprofit Board*** ***March 17***
- ***Effective Strategic Planning*** ***March 30***
- ***Outcomes Management and Evaluation*** ***March 31***
- ***Reporting and Managing Finances*** ***April 13***
- ***Human Resource Management*** ***April 14***

There is no fee to attend the trainings. There is a charge of \$15 each day for meals and snacks. Certificates of completion will be available upon request.

The objectives of the courses are to strengthen leadership and management skills for the current and future generations of nonprofit leaders, to build skills in everything from day-to-day financial and personnel management to high-level leadership and to provide skills needed to run a successful organization.
